- Access plans using computer and tablet
- Plan activities for a crew a minimum of one week in advance
- Have a strong understanding of geometry and math
- Order materials from plans and ask questions when necessary to obtain accurate information
- Frame any roof system and stair system
- Install multiple layered trim and crown molding
- Form complicated concrete pours
- Understand the concept of cutting radiuses and other curves
- Clean up all CCLLC jobs to the standards and requirements of CCLLC policy
- Perform any other task(s) requested by CCLLC
